## **Visiting the School**

We are delighted to welcome back all of our children and families to the school this year. Please note that, for Health and Safety reasons, and as part of our Child Protection policies, parents and guardians must not enter the school building unless they have an appointment or are conducting business in the school office. If you wish to access the front yard, please walk around the school building (to the left from the church carpark). Similarly, if you wish to enter the rear yard from the Dublin Rd entrance, please walk around the new school building (turn right and go around the building). Doors will be closed until the school bell rings. Please do not use the door code to enter the school (Ring doorbell and wait for response). Please do not arrive in school yard before 9.10am. On wet mornings doors will open at 9.10am. (Please see the drop off and collection map on our website) Also please take care when dropping and collecting your child in the church car park or at the Dublin Road entrance. # **Healthy Lunches**

## ARTS CRAFTS PHOTOCOPYING AND BOOK PAYMENT

Our Arts and Crafts and Photocopying payment is an important source of income for the school. It allows the school to provide for materials to help enhance your child's education. - For children in **Junior and Senior Infants** the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* is **€40 plus €10** for *PM Readers and €2 for Sound books* . **Please pay the total amount of €52 during September.**
- For children in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nd classes the contribution for Arts, Crafts and Photocopying is €40 plus €10 for PM Readers.
  Please pay the total amount of €50 during September.
- For children in 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> classes the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* remains at €40. Please pay the total amount of €40 during September.
- For children in 6<sup>th</sup> class the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* is €40 plus €20 for Primary Planet. Please pay the total amount of €60 during September

A  $\in$ 10 reduction will apply to each 2nd and subsequent child in a family for *Arts, Craft and Photocopying*. (2 children  $\in$ 70; 3+ children  $\in$ 100)
