Uniform With regard to the uniform, parents and guardians are asked to abide by the code. Please ensure that for PE days the children have plain navy tracksuits and in particular plain tracksuit bottoms (no stripes). We also allow the children to wear plain *navy shorts* in warm weather. It is very important for the children to abide by the uniform code and we ask that you please try to ensure that your child is in the correct uniform each day.

Attendance Congratulations to all of the children who had good attendance in 2015-2016. Eight of our children achieved perfect attendance. The reports show your child's attendance from September 2014 to the 31st of May 2016.

This year has seen a higher proportion of children missing school more school days than in previous years. (The attendance rate in 2015-2016 was 93.94%. The attendance rate for 2014-2015 was 94.72%) We would ask that all families make a special effort in 2016-2017 to help reverse this trend by ensuring that children only miss days of school in exceptional circumstances.

Sports Swimming will take place during the spring term of 2017 for 2nd 3rd 4th and 5th classes. We hope to be able to provide pitch and putt for 6th class, classes and tennis for all in the summer term. Thanks to Alan McCormack, John Burns, Shane Gorry and James Finnegan for their support over the past year.

The talks that took place through the National Parents Association were very well received by all who attended.
