Arts Crafts and Photocopying

For children in 2nd 3rd 4th and 5th classes the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* remains at €40. **Please pay the total amount of €40 in one or two instalments (September and January).**

For children in **Junior Infants, Senior Infants and 1st class** the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* is €40 plus €10 for *PM Readers*. **Please pay the total amount of €50 in one or two instalments (September and January).**

For children in **6th class** the contribution for *Arts, Crafts and Photocopying* is €40 plus €20 for Primary Planet. **Please pay the total amount of €60 in one or two instalments (September and January).**

- A €10 reduction will apply to each 2nd and subsequent child in a family for *Arts, Craft and Photocopying*. (2 children €70; 3+ children €100)
- When sending this money into school please place it in an envelope and write your child's name on the envelope.
- The amount for Junior, Senior Infants, 1st and 6th class is higher because of the addition of extra materials.

Uniform With regard to the uniform, parents and guardians are asked to abide by the code.
